The first – One Nation Event, India - Maldives Business Conclave followed with India Expo was held at Dharubaaruge on 15, 16 and 17 October 2019, as three days event; where the corporates and public visited and explored the Indian businesses opportunities with the key stakeholders.



Address by Mr. Ali Waheed, Hon. Minister of Tourism, Maldives at the Inaugural Session of India Expo Maldives 2019

The Hon. Minister of Tourism, Maldives Mr. Ali Waheed addressed at the opening ceremony where he mentioned, that India-Maldives relationship will never fade, while an approximate of extra 20,000 Indian Tourists have visited Maldives during August 2019 compared to the count last year. He said medical tourism and processing food are possibilities which they would like to look beyond the horizon.

The Hon. Minister said that the close cooperation between Maldives President Mr. Ibrahim Mohamed Solih and India's Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi has led to a very good development between both countries within the past 11 or so months. He said that both leaders have a special bond that has been instrumental in creating

this atmosphere, besides the cultural and traditional relationship shared between India and Maldives. The Minister added the people of both countries must explore the possibilities and learn the each other's mindset.

The Expo mainly focused on exploring business opportunities between Maldives and Kerala. It is being attended by several Indian companies in collaboration with FICCI.

The Ambassador of India to Maldives, H.E. Mr. Sunjay Sudhir in his speech highlighted the renewed bilateral co-operation between the two countries and the high potential of international trade especially with the enhanced credit line extended to Maldives by Hon Prime Minister of India. H.E. Mr. Sunjay Sudhir also highlighted the potential areas of co-operation between Maldives and India especially in sectors such as Tourism, Health, Education, Skilling Renewable Energy etc.

Kerala being very close to Maldives and already there is substantial trade and business happening between Kerala and Maldives and with the arrival of Business Delegation from Kerala, there is further possibility of increasing the trade & business between Maldives and Kerala and the expected direct ferry/ship service between Maldives and Kochi which is expected to begin service in few months.
