HYDERABAD FEST 2018

Hyderabad Fest 2018 was organised by Spoorthi Progressive Society, Hyderabad from April 13 to 22, 2018 at Telangana Kala Bharathi (NTR Stadium), Indira Park, Hyderabad. Hyderabad Fest was an exhibition with several theme pavilions.

The Fest was lined up with a mix of cultural, science and technology, literature, arts and crafts, public sector and other programmes. This was an exhibition to take knowledge to the people and to make them feel the culture of the Hyderabad city.
