MALABAR CRAFTS MELA 2018

January 16 to 30, 2018 at Indira Gandhi Municipal Stadium, Palakkad, Kerala



The Malabar Crafts Mela was held from January 16 to 30, 2018 at Indira Gandhi Municipal Stadium in Palakkad. The Mela was organised by Department of Industries & Commerce, Government of Kerala in association with Directorate of Industries & Commerce, Directorate of Handlooms & Textiles, Palakkad District Administration and other related Agencies of the Government. Kerala Bureau of Industrial Promotion (K-BIP) under Department of Industries & Commerce was the State level Coordinating Agency of Government of Kerala for the successful conduct of the Event.

The Malabar Crafts Mela was organised with the objective to highlight some of the finest handloom and handicraft traditions of the State and from other States of the Country at par with the Surajkund Crafts Mela organised by Haryana Tourism in North India.

The Malabar Crafts Mela 2018 showcased 134 Nos. exhibition stalls in the form of traditional huts for 112 Nos. Artisans / Craftsmen from Kerala State, 125 Nos. Artisans / Craftsmen from 18 States of India (outside Kerala), 10 Nos. International Artisans from Sri Lanka with more focus on the traditional crafts products and live demonstration of Artisans, 14 Nos. Food Courts for exhibiting ethnic food products, areas for art forms and cultural programmes etc. The Mela will be made as a unique event of Kerala State, India at par with Surajkund and Pushkar Melas in North India.

The Mela selected Artisans / Craftsmen / Non Government Organisations / Organisations from our State in the Traditional Sectors like Handicrafts, Handlooms, Coir, Bamboo, Screwpine, etc. The Skilled artisans / craftsmen from all over the State and from other States of the Country displayed the rich crafts tradition in the typical setting of a rural market place.

Cultural programmes and rural cuisine was part of this colourful Fair. The Mela witnessed the rhythms of folk theatre. Concurrent to the Mela, **Malabar Food Festival** was also organised which provided a forum to showcase unique traditional cuisine of Kerala State for the interest of visitors / tourists. The Food Courts was showcased in traditional styles to cater the popular food dishes of Kerala State especially from the Malabar region.

Partner Country - Sri Lanka

The Srilankan Artisans / Craftsmen displayed their products and skills in the Crafts Mela. The participating Artisans / Craftsmen from Sri Lanka and Officials from the National Crafts Council in Sri Lanka were provided the entire local hospitality including accommodation, food, local conveyance etc.

Artisans / Craftsmen participated from outside Kerala State (from other States of India)



125 Artisans / Craftsmen from 18 States of India (Outside Kerala) registered and participated in the Mela in 72 traditional huts. They displayed variety of products like Handicrafts, Handlooms & Textiles, Handmade ornaments, Brass Products, Leather Products, Pottery, Ceramic Products, Paintings, Soft Toys, Sandal Wood products, Cane & Bamboo Handicrafts, Dry Flowers, Decoration items, Wood Carving and other traditional products manufactured in various parts of India.

Artisans / Craftsmen participated from Kerala



112 Artisans / Craftsmen from the 14 Districts of Kerala displayed their products and skills in 60 traditional huts for the Mela. There was variety of traditional Kerala products such as Handicrafts Items, Handlooms & Textile Products, Coir Products, Bamboo Products, Wood Products, etc.

Malabar Food Festival



Some of the popular food traditions from the Malabar region were introduced in the Mela and 'Malabar Food Festival' was also organised in the two weeks long celebrations. Popular Chinese foods and snack foods also arrived for the Event along with special stalls where visitors were introduced to the traditional foods of Kerala especially of Malabar region.

14 traditional Food Courts displayed the ethnic dishes of Malabar region of Kerala like traditional Malabar Biriyani, Malabar Sweets, Ramassery Idli etc. The food stall by Kudumbasree served traditional foods, tribal foods, sea foods, etc. The Food Festival attracted huge crowd and the ethnic dishes of Malabar region was appreciated by the visitors.

Cultural Evenings

The Mela witnessed the rhythms of folk theatre. Each day evening, there were cultural events staged at the venue. The important folk art forms of Kerala like Otamthullal, Chakyarkootu, Puluvanpattu, Patturumal, Mapillapattu, Tholppavakoothu, Chavittunadakam etc. were displayed apart from the rich folk dances and musical evenings.

State including National & Foreign Tourists visited the Mela and sales worth Rs.4.25 Crores were generated in the Malabar Crafts Mela 2018.
