The Hospitality & Décor Sector comprised of Housekeeping Products & Supplies, Laundry & Cleaning Equipment, Guest amenities, Corporate Gifts & Décor Solutions, In-Room Technology & Entertainment, Furniture & Interiors, Hospitality Support IT Solutions.

This event will continue to act as a catalyst in promoting growth and raising the performance bar for the vital sectors of the economy.
