KERALA @ EXPO 2020 DUBAI

The Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India is organising an India Pavilion at the World Expo 2020 organised from October 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022 at Dubai in UAE. This is the first Expo being held in MEASA (Middle East, Africa and South Asia) region on the theme of Connecting Minds and Creating the Future. The sub themes of the Expo are Opportunity, Mobility and Sustainability.

World Expo is organised every five years, which lasts six months at a time and invites every country in the globe to take part in showcasing the best of what they have to offer. Its aim is to help people and Nations across the Earth to learn by sharing ideas, at the same time demonstrating innovation and further paving the path for progress in fields such as Technology and Architecture.

The Department of Commerce under Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India is the Nodal Department for organising India's participation in the event. This is the first time that the Government of India has decided to involve an Industry Body and Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industries (FICCI) has been selected as an Industry Partner through a rigorous selection process by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry and the Ministry of External Affairs. The India Pavilion is built on a plot of 4614 sq.meters with a display area of about 10,000 sq.meters at the World Expo in Dubai.

The Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) has requested for participation of Kerala in the India Pavilion at the World Expo 2020 during January/February 2022 at Dubai in UAE.

The key focus sectors in the Event are Climate & Biodiversity, Space, Urban & Rural Development, Tolerance & Inclusivity, Golden Jubilee, Knowledge & Learning, Plantation Sector, Tourism & Meity Sector, Travel & Connectivity, Global Goals, Health & Wellness and Food, Agriculture & Livelihoods.

The entire programme will include Industry Engagements, Conferences, Seminars, B2Gs, B2Bs, CEOs Meetings, Government Meetings and Trilateral Engagements etc. The India participation and showcasing will also include Art and Culture Elements.

Vide G.O. (Rt) No.12/2022/ID dated 05/01/2022, Government of Kerala has decided to participate in the World Expo 2020, Dubai from February 4 to 10, 2022. Accordingly the Managing Director, KSIDC and Chief Executive Officer. KBIP visited Dubai from January 17 to 20, 2022 to coordinate the preliminary activities regarding the participation of Government of Kerala in World Expo 2020 from February 4 to 10, 2022.

Based on the pre-visit, it is planned that the inauguration of Kerala Pavilion will be on February 4, 2022 followed by Investor Meets on February 5, 2022 (Industry Focus) and (Norka focus). FICCI will ensure all necessary support to Government of Kerala for the successful conduct of Investor Meets with adequate participation of promising clients from the business fraternity in UAE.

On behalf of Department of Industries & Commerce, the products, services and investment avenues of Directorate of Industries & Commerce, Kerala Bureau of Industrial Promotion (KBIP), Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation (KSIDC), Kerala Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation (KINFRA), Directorate of Handlooms & Textiles and Handicrafts Development Corporation were displayed in the space allotted to Kerala in India Pavilion as part of the industrial promotion activity of the Department. Such participation is an opportunity and a platform for our State to highlight the vast potential of the State in the various industrial sectors before the UAE market and also to exhibit and disseminate the products and technologies. One to one interactions, B2B meetings, etc. was also organised with the trade and business fraternity in UAE concurrent to the participation of Kerala in the India Pavilion in World Expo.

The Kerala Week began on February 4, 2022 in the Indian Pavilion at Expo 2020 Dubai. The special week, aimed at expanding economic possibilities in the State was inaugurated at 5.00 PM at the India Pavilion Expo site by Shri. Pinarayi Vijayan, Hon. Chief Minister, Kerala.
